INAUGURATION CEREMONY OF GREEN eMOTION CHARGING STATIONS AT EUROPEAN COMMISSION PREMISES

With the installation of two charging stations at the European Commission premises of DG MOVE and Energy, Brussels will be included as a small scale demonstration site within the Green eMotion project. This in addition to the nine already existing demonstration regions of Green eMotion: Strasbourg, Ireland (Dublin, Cork), Spain (Madrid, Malaga, Barcelona) Karlsruhe/Stuttgart, Copenhagen, Bornholm, Malmö, Berlin, Italy (Rome, Pisa).

To high-light this activity, the charging stations will be inaugurated by the EC Vice-President responsible for Transport, Siim Kallas. He, joined by his energy counterpart, Mr. Gunther Oettinger and other EC staff will be picked up and driven in electric car to Rue De Mot for the inauguration of the charging stations where the cars will be parked and charged at the stations.

Press people (audiovisual and written) are invited to attend the conference and the inauguration ceremony.

Participants of the conference are invited to walk to Rue De Mot 28-30 (3 minutes' walk) and attend the inauguration of the charging station.
