

Risk-Preparedness Regulation

Informal EURELECTRIC input on the Council position

We welcome the fact that generators and transmission system operators are added to the list of entities that ENTSO-E should consult before submitting methodologies for regional crisis scenarios and short term adequacy assessments. EURELECTRIC suggests that suppliers and other market participants (e.g. balancing responsible parties and storage providers) are also added to this list.

Further steps were made in defining a compensation scheme for Member States providing assistance during electricity crisis situations. However, we regret that the Council does not explicitly cover compensation of market participants for additional costs incurred by power generators in these situations.

We appreciate that the Council added confidentiality requirements for sensitive information and that it has extended the timetables for defining and updating the scenarios and for the identification of the methodologies. However, consistency with the Emergency and Restoration Network Code should be kept in mind when defining deadlines.
