



Knud Pedersen (born 1955) has an MA in Economics from the University of Copenhagen.

From September 2020, Knud Pedersen has been appointed EVP for Distribution and Regulatory Affairs in a new leading Danish Integrated Energy Company called “Andel”. Knud Pedersen is chairman of the board of two electricity distribution companies called “Radius” and “Cerius”. Radius and Cerius are legally unbundled from Andel with their own boards and independent daily management. Radius and Cerius serve 1.4 mill. customers on the Danish island Sjælland, including the Greater Copenhagen area.

From 2010 to 2020, Knud Pedersen was head of Ørsted Distribution, including Ørsted infrastructure activities within power and gas distribution, gas storage and oil transport infrastructure from the North Sea to onshore oil terminal in Denmark.

From 2005 – 2010 Knud Pedersen was Group Vice President in Ørsted responsible for R&D, innovation and regulatory affairs.

Prior to his posts in Andel and Ørsted, Knud Pedersen was a senior civil servant at the Danish Energy Ministry with specific focus on liberalisation and structural reforms in the electricity and gas sectors.

Knud Pedersen is Chairman of The Danish Intelligent Energy Alliance (Danish smart grid association). Knud Pedersen has been chairman of several international task forces on energy policy in the EU and China, and he served as high level Danish representative in EU Council work group negotiating liberalisation of power and gas markets.
