As intern, you will:

 - o European internal electricity market (IEM) policy developments.
 - o The role of flexibility and locational signals in lowering electricity system costs.
 - o Implementation of the Electricity Regulation and Electricity Directive, as well as the Citizens Energy Package.
- Help advisors executing work programmes of Working groups and Committees, including organizing and coordinating the related activities (i.e. meetings, deliverables, advocacy plans, internal communication, etc.)
- Support the process of creating position papers, policy recommendations and other advocacy deliverables, incl. dissemination and lobby campaigns
- Support advisors on ad hoc projects i.e. studies carried out with the support of an external consultant, a project bringing together several stakeholders of the sector
- Other ad hoc actions may include: drafting of briefings, stakeholder mapping, drafting of press articles, preparation of presentations and speaking points

Requirements and competencies:

- Enrolled in a degree in EU affairs, political science, engineering, law or equivalent
- A good understanding of EU policy-making and lobbying, some previous knowledge of the energy sector is a plus
- Diplomatic and with very good inter-personal skills
- Strong written and oral communication skills and a structured mindset
